

AN ACT to further amend The Distillation Prohibition Act. [11 October, 1867.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Asssembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Whosoever makes, distils, rectifies, or compounds, or causes or Penalty for procures to be made, distilled, rectified, or compounded, any low wines, distilling spirits. feints, or spirits whatever, shall, on conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty of not more than Five hundred Pounds and not less than One hundred and fifty Pounds; and whosoever, having been convicted of any such offence afterwards commits any of the said offences in this Section mentioned shall be guilty of a Misdemeanor, and being convicted thereof, shall be imprisoned in some Gaol or House of Correction, and there kept to hard labour for any period not exceeding Two years.

2 The Colonial Treasurer may, either in the Licence issued in that Colonial Treabehalf or by writing under his hand, approve of any person or Body Surer may approve of use of certain Stills under Prohibition Act having, keeping, and using a Still or Stills of less Section 11 of 29 capacity than One hundred and fifty Gallons each.

3 Every person found committing any offence punishable under the Persons found Fifth or Sixth Sections of The Distillation Prohibition Act, or under committing the First Section of this Act, may be detained by any Police Officer may be detained. and taken before any Justice to be dealt with according to law.

Repeal.

4 Section Four of *The Distillation Prohibition Act* is hereby repealed, except as to any offence committed before the commencement of this Act.

Acts to be read together.

5 This Act, and The Distillation Prohibition Act, and The Distillation Prohibition Act, No. 2, save as altered or repealed by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.

Short title.

6 This Act may be cited as "The Distillation Prohibition Act, No. 3."
