AN ACT to further amend *The Distillation Prohibition Act.* [11 October, 1867.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 Whosoever makes, distils, rectifies, or compounds, or causes or procures to be made, distilled, rectified, or compounded, any low wines, feints, or spirits whatever, shall, on conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty of not more than Five hundred Pounds and not less than One hundred and fifty Pounds ; and whosoever, having been convicted of any such offence afterwards commits any of the said offences in this Section mentioned shall be guilty of a Misdemeanor, and being convicted thereof, shall be imprisoned in some Gaol or House of Correction, and there kept to hard labour for any period not exceeding Two years. Penalty for distilling spirits.

2 The Colonial Treasurer may, either in the Licence issued in that behalf or by writing under his hand, approve of any person or Body Corporate licensed under the Eleventh Section of *The Distillation Prohibition Act* having, keeping, and using a Still or Stills of less capacity than One hundred and fifty Gallons each. Colonial Treasurer may approve of use of certain Stills under Section 11 of 29 Vict. No. 12.

3 Every person found committing any offence punishable under the Fifth or Sixth Sections of *The Distillation Prohibition Act*, or under the First Section of this Act, may be detained by any Police Officer and taken before any Justice to be dealt with according to law. Persons found committing certain offences may be detained.

Distillation Prohibition.

Repeal.

4 Section Four of *The Distillation Prohibition Act* is hereby repealed, except as to any offence committed before the commencement of this Act.

Acts to be read together.

5 This Act, and *The Distillation Prohibition Act*, and *The Distillation Prohibition Act, No. 2*, save as altered or repealed by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.

Short title.

6 This Act may be cited as "The Distillation Prohibition Act, No. 3."
