

AN ACT to amend the Law relating to the Registration of Dogs in Country Districts. [25 February, 1858.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The sum of Five Shillings per Dog shall be payable and paid Licence fee to be upon the registration of Dogs under the Act of Council of the 11th Five Shillings per Victoria, No. 7, instead of the sum or sums directed by Section 5 of Dog. the said recited Act: Provided that, if such registration is made after October and before April in any year, one-half only of such sum shall be payable or paid.

2 Any person who, after the 30th day of April, 1858, offends Penalty under against the provisions of Section 2 of the said recited Act, shall forfeit sect. 2, 11 Vict. No. 7, increased and pay a penalty not exceeding Two Pounds and pay a penalty not exceeding Two Pounds.

require the registration of any Dog under the age of Six Months is hereby repealed; and all Dogs shall be registered under the provisions of the said recited Act unless under the age of Four Months.

Appropriates moneys received under 11 Vict. No. 7.

4 All fees and sums received under the authority of the said recited Act, or this Act, shall be paid into the Colonial Treasury and form part of the General Revenue.

Appropriates moneys in hand.

5 All fees and sums received under the authority of the said recited Act, which are in the hands of the Colonial Treasurer on the 30th day of April, 1858, shall form part of the General Revenue.

Repeals sect. 5, partially, and sect. 16, of 11 Vict. No.

6 So much of Section 5 of the said recited Act as relates to the sum or sums to be payable and paid upon the registration of Dogs under the said recited Act, and Section 16 of the said recited Act, are hereby repealed.

This Act and 11 read together.

7 This Act and the said recited Act, except in so far as the same is Vict. No. 7 to be repealed or altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.

Act not to extend to Hobart Town or Launceston.

8 Nothing in this Act contained shall extend to the City of Hobart Town or Town of Launceston.

Commencement of Act.

9 This Act shall commence and take effect on the 31st day of March, 1858.

Short title.

10 In referring to the said recited Act of the 11th Victoria, No. 7, it shall be sufficient to use the expression The Dog Registration Act, 1848; and in referring to this Act it shall be sufficient to use the expression The Dog Registration Act, 1858.
