AN ACT to further amend "The Deep Sinking Encouragement Act, 1899." A.D. 1901.
[7 November, 1901.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Deep Sinking Encouragement Amendment Act, 1901." Short title.

2 In this Act, "the said Act" shall mean "The Deep Sinking Encouragement Act, 1899," as amended by "The Deep Sinking Encouragement Amendment Act, 1901." Interpretation.

3—(1.) Notwithstanding anything contained in Section Six of the said Act, it shall be lawful for the Treasurer to advance and pay to “The *New Pinafore* Gold Mining Company, No Liability,” a further sum not exceeding One thousand Pounds, in addition to the sum of Two thousand Pounds already advanced to such Company.

(2.) Such advance shall be in all respects subject to the terms and conditions contained in the said Act and any Regulations made thereunder.

4 This Act and the said Act shall, save as amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
