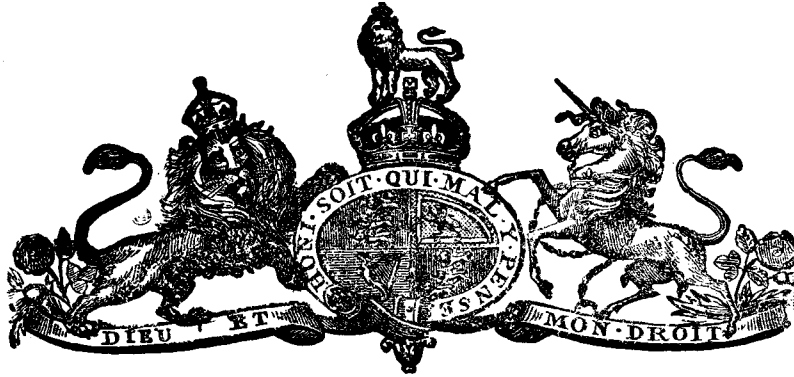

AN ACT to amend "The *Derwent Valley* <sup>A.D.</sup> **1909.**  
 Railway Extension Act, 1908."  
 [30 November, 1909.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The *Derwent Valley* Railway Extension Act, 1909," and shall be incorporated with and construed as one with "The *Derwent Valley* Railway Extension Act, 1908." Short title and incorporation with 8 Ed. VII. No. 28.

**2** Section Four of "The *Derwent Valley* Railway Extension Act, 1908," is hereby amended by repealing the words "Twelve thousand Pounds" wherever they occur, and substituting therefor the words "Nineteen thousand Pounds." This amendment shall be deemed to have been made at the commencement of the lastmentioned Act. Amendment of Section 4 of 8 Ed. VII. No. 28.
