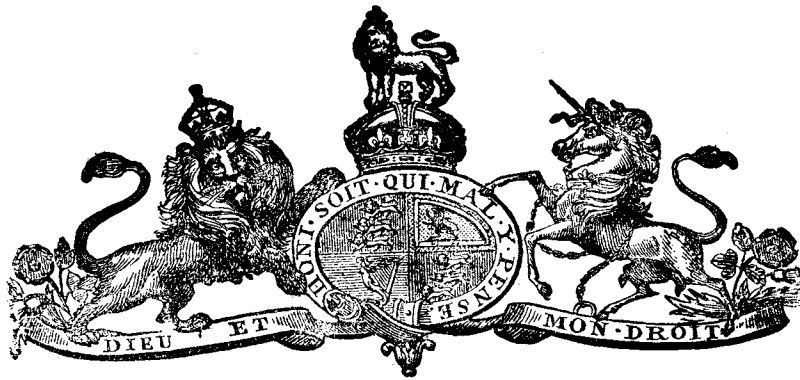

AN ACT to amend "The Deloraine Water Act, 1902." A.D. 1911.
[10 January, 1912.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 In this Act—

"The Corporation" means the Warden, councillors, and electors of the Municipality of Deloraine :
 "The Council" means the Council of the said Municipality.

Interpretation.

2 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Deloraine Water District Loan Act, 1911." Short title.

3 This Act and "The Deloraine Water Act, 1902," save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

4 Notwithstanding anything contained in Section Forty-four of "The Deloraine Water Act, 1902," it shall be lawful for the Council Council may borrow.

on behalf of the Municipality to borrow, under the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," for water-supply purposes in connection with the waterworks of the Deloraine Water District, established under "The Deloraine Water Act, 1902"—Any sum or sums of money, not exceeding the sum of Seven hundred Pounds, for the purpose of purchasing a new water-pump, with driving motor, pipes, and fittings, and of constructing necessary buildings and well, and erecting necessary plant and works in connection therewith.

Loan may be
granted.

5 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to grant from time to time to the Council, upon the security of all its revenues, as a loan or loans for the purposes aforesaid or any of them, any sum or sums, not exceeding in the whole the sum of Seven hundred Pounds, in accordance with the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890"; and such sum or sums shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for that purpose: Provided that it shall not be necessary to lay before either House of Parliament plans and specifications of any of such proposed works, nor a report of the Engineer-in-Chief thereon as provided in Section Two of the last-mentioned Act. Provided that before any of the said sums shall be advanced to the Council the Engineer-in-Chief shall have certified that he is satisfied with the manner in which the Council proposes to spend the money, and that the work proposed to be effected with such money can in his opinion be completed for the amount proposed to be borrowed therefor.

Poll to be taken.

6 The Council shall not proceed to borrow any sum of money under the authority of this Act until and after a poll has been taken of the electors of the Municipality of Deloraine who are owners or occupiers of property within the Water and Light District of Deloraine, for the purpose of ascertaining whether the Council shall proceed to borrow such sum. If at the taking of such poll the number of votes recorded in favour of the Council proceeding to borrow any such sum shall amount to Two-thirds or more of the total number of the valid votes recorded at such poll in relation to the question of borrowing such sum, then the Council may proceed to borrow such sum accordingly, but otherwise the Council shall not proceed to borrow such sum: Provided that if at any such poll the number of votes recorded in favour of the Council proceeding to borrow any such sum shall not be sufficient to authorise the Council to borrow such sum as aforesaid, the Council may, at any time after the expiration of Three months from the taking of such poll, take another poll of such owners and occupiers for the purposes of ascertaining whether the Council shall proceed to borrow such sum, and so on from time to time, after the expiration of a like period; and if at any such poll Two-thirds of the votes recorded shall be in favour of the Council borrowing, the Council may proceed to borrow.

Deloraine Water.

7 Subject to the provisions of this Act, any poll taken for the purposes aforesaid shall be taken as far as practicable in a similar manner to the taking of a poll upon an election of councillors of a municipality under the provisions of "The Local Government Act, 1906," and any elector of the municipality of Deloraine who is the owner or occupier of property within the Water and Light District of Deloraine shall be entitled to the same number of votes as he would be entitled to in case of an election of councillors of a municipality; and the ballot-papers to be used in the taking of any such poll shall be in the form set forth in the schedule to this Act.

Procedure at
polls.

8 Before the Council shall take any poll of the owners and occupiers as aforesaid, the Council shall cause a notice of such poll to be advertised Three times in a daily newspaper circulating in the Municipality of Deloraine, and in Two consecutive numbers of the "Hobart Gazette," and the last of such advertisements shall be published not more than One week before the taking of such poll; and such advertisement shall contain the following particulars :--

SCHEDULE.**BALLOT-PAPER.**
