## AN ACT to amend "The Electoral Act, 1907." 1922. <br> [27 October, 1922.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :--

1 This Act may be cited as " The Electoral Act, 1922."
2 Schedule (2) to "The Electoral Act, 1907," is hereby amended by expunging the several descriptions and boundaries of the Five Assembly Divisions therein set forth, and substituting therefor the several descriptions and boundaries of the said Five Assembly Divisions set forth in the Schedule to this Act.
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Alteration of boundaries of Assembly Divisions not to affect their representation in Parliament.

3 Notwithstanding the alteration, by this Act, of the description and boundaries of any Assembly Division, every member of the Assembly shall continue to represent, in Parliament, the Assembly Division of the same name as the Assembly Division for which he was elected, but with the description and boundaries assigned to it by this Act.

## S C HEDULE.

## DESCRIPTIONS AND BOUNDARIES OF ASSEMBLY DIVISIONS.

Bass.
Commencing at Low Head, on the River Tamar; thence after crossing that river, by the west bank thereof to the boundary of the town of Trevallyn; thence by the north-west and south-west boundaries of that town to the South Esk River; thence by that river, and after crossing the same, by the south-west, the southeast, and the north-east boundaries of the city of Launceston to the North Esk River, by that river (after crossing the same) to its source; thence by a northeasterly line to a point distant 1 mile or thereabouts southerly from the southwest angle of 313a. 3r. 5p. purchased by W. All the islands adjacent to the coast north of Scamander River, and all islands in Bass Strait east of the 147th degree of longitude and south of 39 degrees and 12 minutes of latitude, form part of this division.

King Island and all islands in Bass Strait west of the 146 th degree of longitude and south of 39 degrees and 12 minutes of latitude form part of this division.

## Denison.

All islands in Bass Strait between the 146th and 147th degrees of longitude and south of the 39 degrees and 12 minutes of latitude and all islands adjoining the coast between the Scamander and Little Swanport Rivers form part of this division.
