

AN ACT to further amend "The Education A.D. 1899. [29 September, 1899.] Act, 1885."

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Education Amendment Act, Short title. 1899."
- 2 Upon the application of the parent of any child the Minister Railway passes to may, at his discretion, authorise the issue of a Free Pass to any child children to attend between the ages of Seven and Fifteen years to travel in a suitable other than State railway carriage or van on the Government Railways to and from any Schools. railway carriage or van on the Government Railways to and from any State School or Private School approved of by the Minister, and situate within a radius of Ten miles of the residence of the parents of such child.

- 3 The operation of this Act shall cease on the Thirty-first day of Duration of Act. December, One thousand nine hundred and one.
- 4 This Act and "The Education Act, 1885," save as altered by this Acts to be read Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
