# AN ACT to amend "The Electoral Act, 1901." A.D. 1904. [21 April, 1904.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Electoral Amendment Act, Short title, 1904."
- 2 In this Act, "the said Act" shall mean "The Electoral Act, Interpretation. 1Ed. VII. No. 57.
- 3 The words "then on any Electoral Roll in force, and" in the Amendment of second and third lines of Section Twenty-six of the said Act are hereby expunged. This Section shall have retrospective effect as from the First day of January, One thousand nine hundred and four.
- 4 The words "and shall first sign his name, or place his mark Amendment of opposite to his name, upon a certified copy of the Electoral Roll" in 1 Ed. VII. No. 57. the second and third lines of Sub-section (1.) of Section Eighty-seven of the said Act are hereby expunged.

8 The Schedule (4.) to the said Act is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof the Schedule (1.) hereto shall be and be deemed to be and may be cited as Schedule (4.) to the said Act.

9 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in Section Seventeen of the said Act, Electoral Rolls for the House of Assembly Districts may be in the form set forth in the Schedule (5.) to the said Act, or in the form set forth in the Schedule (2.) to this Act.

Acts to be read together.

10 This Act and the said Act, save as altered or amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.

#### RETURNING OFFICER'S DECLARATION.

I, A.B., the Returning Officer of the Electoral District of do hereby solemnly and sincerely declare, that I will faithfully assist in all elections of a Member or Members to serve in Parl ament for the said District; and that I will not in any manner interfere with any elector when filling up his Ballot-paper at any such election or attempt to ascertain the name or names of the candidate or candidates for whom any elector votes at any such election; and in case I should become acquainted with the name or names of the candidate or candidates for whom any elector votes, then that I will not disclose to any person whomsoever the fact so coming to my knowledge, nor by any word or action directly or indirectly aid in discovering the same, except in answer to any question which I am legally bound to answer, or in compliance with the provisions of "The Electoral Act, 1901."
