

AN ACT to continue "The Electoral Act, A.D. 1902. 1896," so far as the same applies to the Election of Members of the House of Assembly of Tasmania.

[29 September, 1902.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows: ---

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Electoral Act Continuation Act, Short title. 1902."
- 2 "The Electoral Act, 1896," as amended by "The Electoral Act 60 Vict. No. 49 Continuation and Amendment Act, 1899," and "The Electoral Act as amended by 63 Continuation and Amendment Act, 1900," shall remain and continue in full force and operation, so far as the same applies to the Election of continued. Members of the House of Assembly of Tasmania, until the present House of Assembly of Tasmania is dissolved or expires by effluxion of time.

Certain vacancies in House of Assembly need not be filled up. 3 Notwithstanding anything contained in any Act of the Parliament of Tasmania, it shall not be necessary for the Governor to issue a writ for the election of a Member to fill any vacancy which may occur in the House of Assembly of Tasmania between the date of the prorogation of the present Session of Parliament and the date when the present House of Assembly of Tasmania is dissolved or expires by effluxion of time.
