

AN ACT to rectify an Error in the Description of the Esperance Lighting Area and to validate certain Proceedings in relation thereto. [23 December, 1932.]

A.D. 1932.

WHEREAS a poll of the ratepayers within a certain area was PREAMBLE. taken by the Council of the Municipality of Esperance on the tenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twentyseven, to decide upon the question of borrowing certain moneys for the purposes of supplying such area with lighting and of matters incidental thereto, and such question was decided in the affirmative:

Esperance Lighting Validation.

And whereas in the preparation of the Esperance Lighting Act, 1927, enacted to give effect to the purposes aforesaid, portion of the area aforesaid was accidentally omitted from the schedule thereto, wherefore the same is not legally part of the intended lighting area:

And whereas rates have been levied and collected without legal authority in respect of the part of the said area so omitted:

And whereas it is desirable to rectify the said omission and to validate the levying and collection of the said rates:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as "The Esperance Lighting Validation Act, 1932."

Rectification of error in definition of lighting area in 18 Geo. V. No. 63.

2 The lighting area defined in the schedule to the Esperance Lighting Act, 1927, shall include, and shall be deemed at all times to have included for all purposes the whole of the areas which comprise the Liverpool Ward and the Geeveston Ward respectively of the Municipality of Esperance.

3 The making, levying, and collection of any rate heretofore levied for the purposes of the Esperance Lighting Act, 1927, or the Local Authorities Lighting Act, 1930, in respect of any part of the lighting area, as provided by Section Two, shall be deemed to have been as valid and effectual as if this Act had been in operation when such rate was made and levied.
