AN ACT to amend "An Act to make better provision for the Supply of Water to the Town of *Evandale* for the benefit of the Inhabitants thereof." [29 September, 1899.] A.D. 1899.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 In this Act, the words "the said Act" shall mean the Act of the Parliament of *Tasmania* intituled "An Act to make better provision for the Supply of Water to the Town of *Evandale* for the benefit of the Inhabitants thereof." Interpretation. 58 Vict. No. 33.

2 This Act may be cited as "The *Evandale* Water Amendment Act, 1899," and the said Act may be cited as "The *Evandale* Water Act, 1894." Short title.

3 The word "Four" in the Fifth and Sixth lines of Section Twenty-four of the said Act is hereby expunged, and the word "Three" is hereby inserted in the said lines respectively in lieu thereof, and the said Section shall be hereafter construed as if the word "Three" had originally been inserted therein. Amendment Section 24 of 58 Vict. No. 33.

4 This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act. Acts to be read together.
