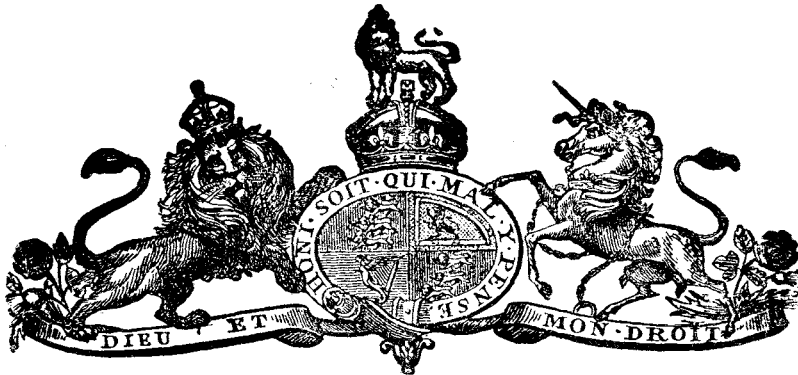

AN ACT to amend "The Fertilisers Act, 1912." A.D. 1924.
[6 December, 1924.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Fertilisers Act, 1924." Short title.
- 2 "The Fertilisers Act, 1912," is hereby amended—
 - i. By inserting after the word "plants," in the fourth line of the definition of "Fertiliser," in Section Three thereof, the words "or any lime or compounds of lime"; and by deleting the word "lime" from the fifth line of the same definition: Amendment of 3 Geo. V. No. 23. Section 3.

ii. By inserting after the definition of "Inspector," in the same section, the following new definition:—

"'Lime' means—

- (a) Caustic lime, burnt lime, or quick lime in the form of calcium oxide;
- (b) Mild lime or air-slaked lime, containing the lime chiefly in the form of hydrate of lime, obtained by slaking burnt lime; or
- (c) Agricultural lime, containing lime in the form of carbonate of lime, obtained by the crushing or pulverising of limestone, marble, coral, or shells": and

Section 6.

iii. By deleting the words "thirty-first day of January" from the third line of Section Six thereof, and substituting therefor the words "first day of November."
