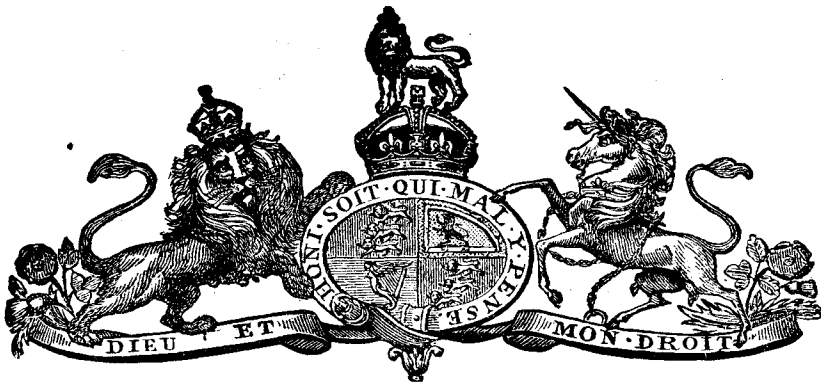

AN ACT to authorise the Execution of certain Road Works out of Moneys to be provided by the Commonwealth.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Federal Aid Roads Execution Act, 1932.” Short title.

Interpretation.

14.**2** In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—

“The Agreement” means the Agreement between the Commonwealth and the State authorised by the Commonwealth and State Roads Agreement Act, 1926, as modified by the Agreement ratified by the Commonwealth and State Roads Agreement Act, 1931 :

“Federal Aid Roads” means any roads in respect of which any works are authorised by Parliament to be carried out under the Agreement.

Power to

3—(1) The Minister may cause the Federal Aid Road works specified in the Second Schedule to be executed and carried out at a cost for each separate work so specified not exceeding the amount set forth in that schedule in respect thereof.

(2) Where by any subsequent Act the execution of any Federal Aid Road works is authorised, those works may be executed and carried out in accordance with the provisions of this Act at such cost respectively as may be specified in the Act authorising the execution thereof.

4 The provisions of the Public Works Construction Act, 1880, and the Branch Roads Construction Act, 1881, shall apply to the execution of Federal Aid Road works in the same manner as if those provisions had been incorporated in this Act.

5 Any land required for the purpose of any Federal Aid Road works, at the option of the Minister, may be acquired under the Lands Resumption Act, 1910, or the Land Vesting Act, 1894.

Cost of works,
how defrayed.

6 The cost of executing and carrying out Federal Aid Road works shall be defrayed out of moneys to be provided by the Commonwealth in accordance with the Agreement.

Federal Aid

7 All moneys received by the Treasurer from the Commonwealth in accordance with the Agreement shall be placed to the credit of the account kept in the books of the Treasurer and called “The Federal Aid Roads Trust Fund,” and all expenditure under this Act, or any subsequent Act authorising the execution of any Federal Aid Road works, shall be debited to that account.

Maintenance

8—(1) All Federal Aid Roads, after the same have been completed, constructed, or reconstructed, as the case may be, shall be adequately and continuously maintained in good repair and condition—

Federal Aid Roads Execution.

- I. If any such road is a State highway, by the Minister in accordance with the State Highways Maintenance Act, 1929: or
- II. In any other case—
- (a) By and at the expense of the municipality within which the road is situated; or
- (b) If the road forms the boundary between adjoining municipalities, by and at the joint expense of those municipalities.
- (2) If at any time a municipality makes default in maintaining any Federal Aid Road in accordance with this section, the Minister may cause the necessary maintenance work to be carried out, and the cost thereof may be recovered from that municipality under the Crown Remedies Act, 1891, as a debt due to His Majesty.
- (3) This section shall apply to Federal Aid Roads constructed under any of the Acts repealed by this Act.

9 Any amounts advanced by the Treasurer prior to the commencement of this Act, for the purposes of any Federal Aid Roads, in excess of the amount standing to the credit of the Federal Aid Roads Trust Fund, shall be made good out of the moneys received or to be received from the Commonwealth, in accordance with the Agreement, during the financial years ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two, and the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three respectively.

Advances by Treasurer to be made good out of moneys received from the Commonwealth.

10—(1) If the moneys received from the Commonwealth, in accordance with the Agreement—

Reduction of amounts specified in Second Schedule in certain cases.

I. In respect of the financial years mentioned in Section Nine, should be insufficient to provide for the amounts to be made good under that section and for the cost of the works authorised by this Act: or

II. In respect of any subsequent financial year, should be insufficient to provide for the cost of the Federal Aid Road works authorised for that year—

the Minister may reduce all or any of the amounts specified as the cost of the works so authorised, or for supervision thereof, in such manner as he thinks fit, or may refrain from carrying out any of the works so authorised, in order to bring the amount to be applied within the total of the moneys received or to be received from the Commonwealth in respect of the particular period.

11 The Acts set forth in the First Schedule are hereby repealed.
