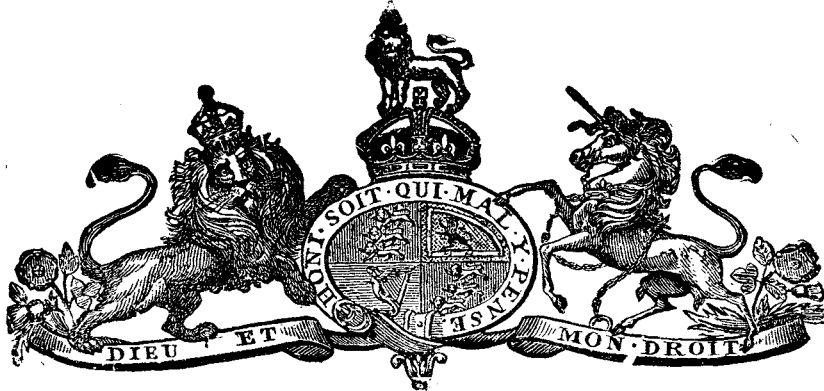

AN ACT to amend the Fish Canning
 Encouragement Act, 1925.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Fish Canning Encouragement Act, 1929.” Short title.

2 The Fish Canning Encouragement Act, 1925, is hereby amended by deleting the word “three” in the first line of Section Five and in the first line of Paragraph 1. of Section Six thereof (as inserted by the Fish Canning Encouragement Act, 1927), and substituting therefor in each case the word “five.” Amendment of 16 Geo. V. No. 46, Sections 5 and 6.

3 The Fish Canning Encouragement Act, 1927, is hereby repealed. Repeal of 18 Geo. V. No. 100.
