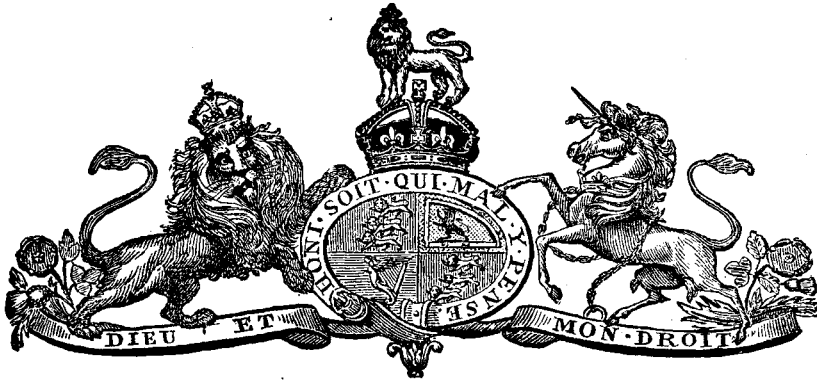

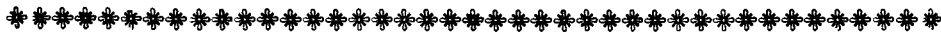

AN ACT to abolish Fees in Primary State Schools. [3 December, 1908.]

A.D. 1908.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows; that is to say:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Free Education Act, 1908,” and shall be construed with “The Education Act, 1885.”

2 On and after the First day of *January*, One thousand nine hundred and nine, no fees shall be charged for education in primary State schools.
