TESTATOR'S FAMILY MAINTENANCE.

No. 57 of 1970.

AN ACT to amend the Testator's Family Maintenance Act 1912. [15 December 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Testator's Family Maintenance Act* 1970.

(2) The Testator's Family Maintenance Act 1912, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Contents of order.

Short title and citation.

2 Section nine of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection (5) of that section, after the word "by", the words "increasing or "; and by adding at the end of that paragraph "or by varying such order in such manner as the Court or judge thinks proper "; and
- (b) by inserting after that subsection the following subsection:-

"(5A) The Court or a judge shall not, in the exercise of the power conferred on it or him by paragraph (b) of subsection (5) of this section, alter an order under this Act so as to disturb a distribution of any part of the estate that was lawfully made before the making of the application for the alteration.".

3 The amendments of section nine of the Principal Act that are Operation of made by this Act apply in relation to—

- (a) the estates of persons who died before the commencement of this Act as well as the estates of persons who die after that commencement; and
- (b) any order under the Principal Act made in relation to an estate before the commencement of this Act as well as any such order made after that commencement.

TIMBER PROMOTION.

No. 58 of 1970.

AN ACT to provide for the establishment of a Tasmanian Timber Promotion Board for the promotion of the use of wood, and for the making of funds available to the Board for that purpose.

[18 December 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Timber Promotion Act* Short title and com-1970.

(2) This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

- 2 In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears— Interpre-
 - "Board" means the Tasmanian Timber Promotion Board established under this Act;
 - "Fund" means the Tasmanian Timber Promotion Fund established under section eight;

"Principal Act" means the Forestry Act 1920,

and other words and expressions to which meanings are assigned by the Principal Act have respectively the same meanings as they have for the purposes of that Act.
