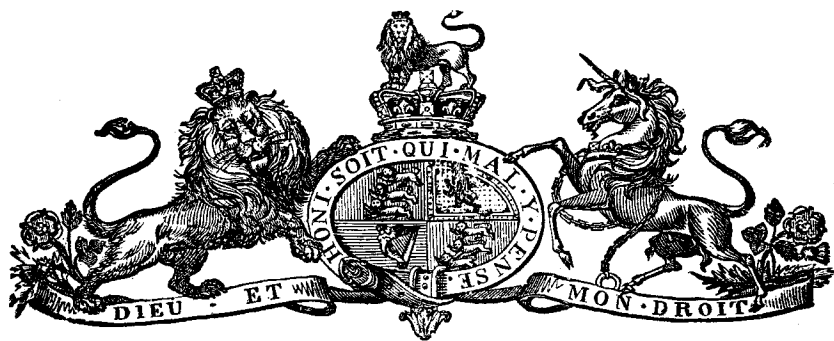

AN ACT to make permanent the Act of this Island,
intituled *An Act to regulate Friendly Societies.*
[28 April, 1857.]

WHEREAS by Section 34 of the Act of this Island of the Nineteenth **PREAMBLE.**
Victoria, No. 26, it was enacted that the said Act should continue and **19 Vict. No. 26**
be in force until the expiration of six months after the first meeting of
the Parliament of *Tasmania*, and no longer : And whereas it is expedient
that the said Act should be continued and made permanent: Be it
therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of
Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 The said recited Act of the Nineteenth *Victoria*, No. 26, intituled **Friendly Societies**
An Act to regulate Friendly Societies, is hereby continued and made **Act made perma-**
permanent. **ment.**

2 In referring to the said recited Act it shall be sufficient to use the **Short Title.**
expression "*The Friendly Societies Act.*"
