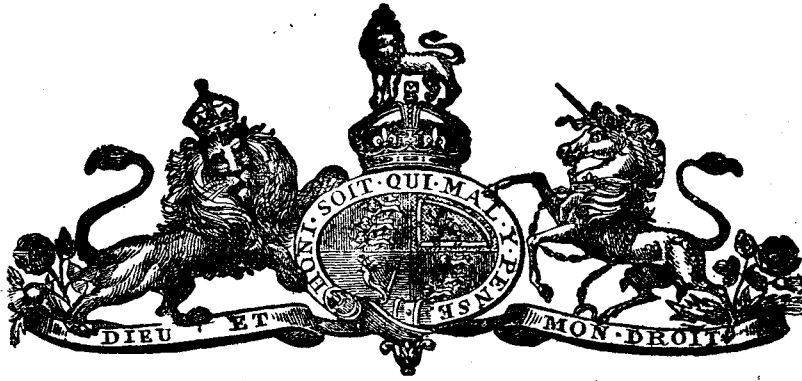

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title and incorporation with 4 Ed. VII. No. 19.
2. Repeal of Section 13 of 7 Geo. V. No. 46 and schedule.
Reconstruction of Fingal Water District.

AN ACT to further Amend "The Fingal Water Act, 1904." [22 December, 1917.] A.D. 1917.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Fingal Water Amendment Act (No. 2), 1917," and shall be read and incorporated with "The Fingal Water Act, 1904" (hereinafter called "the Principal Act"), and any amendment thereof. Short title and incorporation with 4 Ed. VII. No. 19.

2 Section Thirteen of "The Fingal Water Amendment Act, 1917," and the schedule thereto are hereby repealed, and the area of land (which includes the town of Fingal) described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a water district under and for the purposes of the Principal Act, and of "The Fingal Water Amendment Act, 1917," and shall be called the Fingal Water District. Principal Act and in "The Fingal Water Amendment Act, 1917," the word "district" is used the same shall mean and include the Fingal Water District as described in the said schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

FINGAL WATER DISTRICT.

Commencing on the south bank of the South Esk River at its intersection with the south-west boundary of the town of Fingal (*i.e.* at a point in line with the south-west side of Manley-street) thence south-easterly by the south-west side of Manley-street to a point in line with the south-eastern side of Robert-street thence north-easterly across Manley-street and by the south-easterly side of Robert-street to the south-western boundary of the Crown Reserve on the Fingal Rivulet thence by the south-western boundary of said reserve to the south-eastern boundary of Lot 5 Section D3 thence north-easterly in line with the south-eastern boundary of Lot 5 Section D3 to a point Two chains from the north-eastern bank of the Fingal Rivulet situated in Lot 4264 purchased by R. G. Talbot thence northerly by a line Two chains distant from the north-eastern bank of the Fingal Rivulet to a point situated in Lot 32 purchased by W. Talbot and in line with the north-westerly side of Robert-street thence north-westerly to the eastern corner of Lot 2 Section GG thence north-westerly by the Fingal Rivulet to the north side of Percy-street thence westerly by the north side of Percy-street and its continuation to the bank of the South Esk River thence southerly by the bank of that river to the point of commencement.
