AN ACT to amend the Tasmanian Government Insurance Act 1919 with respect to the re-insurance of risks arising outside the State.

[Royal Assent 14 December 1979]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Tasmanian Government Short title. Insurance Amendment Act 1979.

Commencement.

2—This Act shall commence on the seventh day after the date of assent to this Act.

Amendment of section 2 of Tasmanian Government Insurance Act 1919 (Interpretation).

3—Section 2 of the *Tasmanian Government Insurance Act* 1919* is amended by omitting "situate in this State" from the definition of "fire insurance" and substituting "whether situated in this State or elsewhere".
