AN ACT to amend the Tasmanian Government Insurance Act 1919 with respect to the re-insurance of risks arising outside the State.

[Royal Assent 14 December 1979]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Tasmanian Government Insurance Amendment Act 1979*. Short title.

Commencement. **2**—This Act shall commence on the seventh day after the date of assent to this Act.

3—Section 2 of the *Tasmanian Government Insurance Act 1919** is amended by omitting “situate in this State” from the definition of “fire insurance” and substituting “whether situated in this State or elsewhere”.
