AN ACT to amend the Tasmanian Government Insurance Act 1919.

[Royal Assent 8 December 1987]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Tasmanian Government* Short title. *Insurance Amendment Act 1987*.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives commencement. the Royal assent.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Tasmanian Government Insurance Act* 1919* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Insertion of new section 7A in Principal Act. 4—After section 7 of the Principal Act, the following section is inserted:—

Protection for members of Board, &c.

- 7A—(1) A member of the Board or an officer appointed under section 7 shall not incur any personal liability in respect of any act or thing done, or omitted to be done, in good faith in the administration or execution, or purported administration or execution, of this Act.
- (2) Nothing in subsection (1) precludes the Board from being subject to any action, liability, claim, or demand to which the Board is subject.
