

AN ACT to make provision in respect of the A.D. 1883. Salary and Allowances of His Excellency the

Governor of Tasmania.

[Reserved, 29 October, 1883; Royal Assent proclaimed, 21 January, 1884.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 The Acts mentioned in the Schedule (1) shall be and are hereby Repeal. repealed, save as to all things duly done thereunder.
- 2 There shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Sums payable this Colony, for and in respect of the Salary and Allowances of every annually for Governor of this Colony, the sums set forth in the Schedule (2). And Governor's Salary, &c. such sums shall include all provision for the Travelling Expenses of the Governor, Fuel and Light for Government House, Stationery and Stores, and all other expenses, except the cost of the Furniture and Repairs hereinafter mentioned.

3 The Government House, together with its stables, outbuildings, Government fences, and other appurtenances, shall be kept in substantial repair, and House to be kept the whole of the rooms in the said House shall be kept and furnished in repair, and furnished out of throughout, and the cost thereof shall be defrayed out of the Con- Consolidated solidated Revenue Fund.

Revenue Fund.

The cost of such Repairs and Furniture shall not exceed in any one year the sum of Six hundred Pounds.

Commencement of Act.

4 This Act shall commence and take effect upon the publication in The Hobart Gazette of the Governor's Proclamation signifying that Her Majesty has been pleased to assent to the same.

Short title.

5 This Act may be cited as "The Governor's Salary Act, 1883."
