

AN ACT to regulate the Salary of Officers A.D. 1887. administering the Government of Tasmania, and for other purposes.

[20 December, 1887.]

WHEREAS it is now competent to the Secretary of State for the PREAMBLE. Colonies by official Regulation to require Governors and Officers administering the Government to make such a distribution of the emoluments of office as he considers expedient:

And whereas it is desirable to regulate by Law the distribution of the emoluments of the office of Governor during the absence or incapacity of the Governor or vacancy of the office, and to regulate certain other matters connected therewith, in manner hereinafter provided:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 An Officer appointed to be Governor of Tasmania shall receive Governor shall half salary from the date at which he embarks to assume the Govern- receive half salary ment, whether the port of embarkation be in England, or in another from embarkation. Colony, or elsewhere.

2 If, however, a Governor continues in the tenure of his Office until Unless former the arrival of his successor, the latter Officer shall not be entitled to any portion of the salary until he has assumed the duties of his Office.

Governor continues in office until, &c.

Salary of Officer administering Government.

If office vacated after embarkation successor to receive half salary.

- 3 If the Office is vacated after the incoming Governor has embarked to assume the Government, he shall receive half salary from the date of such vacancy.
- 4 If the Governor be absent from Tasmania or incapacitated from Governor to draw performing the duties of his Office, and another Officer be sworn to half salary during administer the Government, the Governor shall receive half salary absence, &c.

 during the administration of such Officer during the administration of such Officer.

Officers administering the Government to draw half salary.

5 An Officer provisionally administering the Government of Tasmania during the absence or incapacity of the Governor, or during a vacancy of the Office, shall receive one-half of the salary of Governor.

Such Officers may appoint Staff.

6 An Officer so administering the Government may appoint the same Staff as a Governor, and if any of the persons so appointed shall not hold any other office of profit or emolument they shall respectively receive the full salaries of their respective offices; but if any of the persons so appointed shall hold any other office of profit or emolument, such persons shall respectively receive only one-half of the salaries attached to the respective offices to which they are respectively appointed on the Governor's Staff.

Such Officers are entitled to the full allowances of a Governor.

7 An Officer so administering the Government shall be entitled to the full allowances of a Governor if there is money available, but he shall only receive so much of the vote as is proportioned to the time he is in office.

Short Title.

8 This Act may be cited as "The Governor's Salary Act, 1887."
