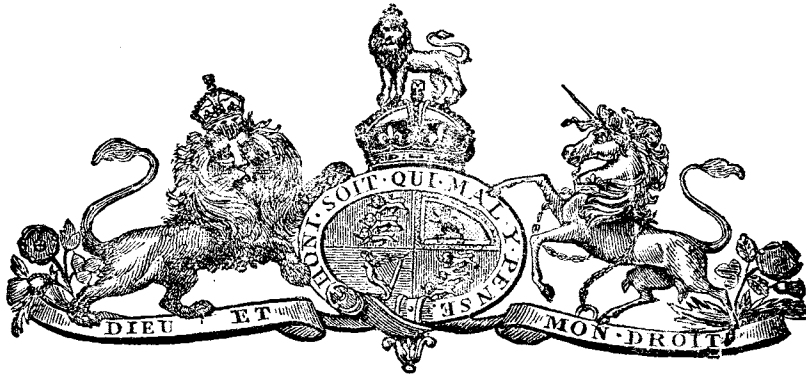

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Governor's Salary Act, 1930."

Short title.

**2** The Governor's Salary Act, 1887, is hereby amended—

I. By repealing Section Four thereof: and

Section 4.

II. By deleting the words "one-half of the salary of Governor" at the end of Section Five, and substituting therefor the words "an annual allowance of Seven hundred and fifty Pounds".

Performance of  
duties in absence  
of Administrator.

**3** Upon the request in writing of the Administrator, it shall be lawful for any judge of the Supreme Court, who consents so to do, to preside at any meeting of the Executive Council, or to sign any document for and on behalf of the Administrator, or to perform any other official function of a similar nature for and on behalf of the Administrator, and such judge while so acting shall have all the powers and authority of the Administrator.
