

AN ACT to amend "The Glenorchy Water A.D. 1891. [23 December, 1891.] Act, 1890."

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend "The Glenorchy Water Act, PREAMBLE. 1890," in the manner hereinafter appearing:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Glenorchy Water Short title. Act Amendment Act, 1891."
- 2 In the construction and for the purposes of this Act, unless the Interpretation. context otherwise determines-

The expression "the said Act" shall mean "The Glenorchy Water Act, 1890":

The expression "the said Trustees" shall mean the Trustees for the time being of the Glenorchy Water District.

3 Notwithstanding anything in the said Act contained, it shall be Trustees may lawful for the said Trustees to borrow and take up at interest in the borrow. manner directed by the said Act, or in accordance with the provisions of this Act, such sum or sums of money not exceeding £12,000 (Twelve thousand Pounds) in the whole as shall from time to time be necessary for effectuating the objects authorised by the said Act.

4 It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, under and subject Governor in to the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," to Council may grant to the said Trustees as loans for effectuating the objects of the said Act, any sum or sums of money not exceeding £12,000 (Twelve thousand Pounds) in the whole.

5 This Act and the said Act, save as amended by this Act, shall be Acts to be read together. read and construed together as one Act.
