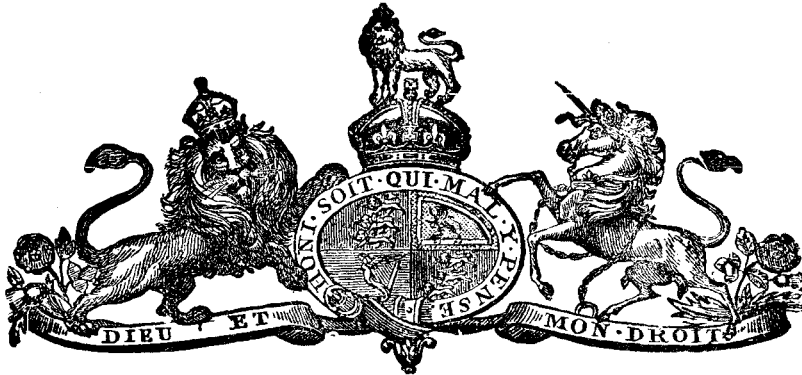

AN ACT to amend "The Hobart Corporation Acts, 1893-1924." A.D. 1924.
[13 January, 1925.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Hobart Corporation Acts, 1893-1924," in manner hereinafter appearing: PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Hobart Corporation Act, Short title. (No. 2), 1924."

(2) "The Hobart Corporation Act, 1893," and every amendment 57 Vict. No. 11. thereof, inclusive of this Act, may together be cited as "The Hobart Corporation Acts, 1893-1924."

2 Section Eighteen of "The Hobart Corporation Act, 1924," is hereby amended—

- i. By inserting after the figures "18" in the first line thereof the figure "(1)":
- ii. By adding at the end thereof the following new Subsections (2) and (3):—

"(2) Within a period of five years from the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, all columns of verandahs erected over any portion of such parts of the streets mentioned in Subsection (3) of this section as are within the boundaries of the City of Hobart, and as are not included within the area described in Schedule (1), shall be completely removed.

"(3) The streets referred to in Subsection (2) of this section are—

Macquarie Street	Harrington Street Deviation
Cascade Road	Montpelier Road
Elizabeth Street	High Street, Sandy Bay
Main Road, New Town	Sandy Bay Road"

3 Section Eight of "The Mountain Park Act, 1906," is hereby amended by adding at the end of Subparagraph (1) of the said section the following additional proviso:—

"Provided further that a lease of any portion of any such area not exceeding two acres may be granted, subject as aforesaid, to any person for a term not exceeding twenty-one years, to be used for such recreation purposes or to be improved or beautified in such manner as may be provided in the lease thereof."

4 It shall be lawful for the Council to expend such sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the whole One hundred Pounds in any one financial year, in aid or in furtherance of the work of the Child Welfare Association of Hobart. Any sum or sums of money so expended shall be charged to the health account, and any expenditure heretofore made for the purposes aforesaid is hereby authorised and declared legal.
