

******** A.D. AN ACT to enable the Mayor, Aldermen, and 1925. Citizens of the City of Hobart to borrow a Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding Eighty thousand Pounds for the purpose of Constructing and Improving Streets, extending the Sewerage System, and for other purposes. [16 December, 1925.]

W HEREAS it is expedient that the Corporation of Hobart should PREAMBLE. be empowered to borrow the sum or sums of money hereinafter specified for the purposes hereinafter set forth :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 This Act may be cited as the "The Hobart Corporation Loans Short title Act, 1925."

Hobart Corporation Loans.

A.D. 1925.

Interpretation.

2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines –

"The Corporation" means the Corporation of the Mayor, aldermen, and citizens of the City of Hobart :

"The Council" means the Hobart City Council.

Power to borrow £80,000 for certain purposes.

3 It shall be lawful for the Corporation from time to time to borrow and take up at interest on the security of the whole of the revenues of the Corporation, such sum or sums of money as the Corporation deems necessary for the respective purposes hereinafter in this section set forth, not exceeding in each case the sum of money herein mentioned in respect of each such purpose:—

4 The provisions of Sections Four to Ten inclusive of the Hobart Corporation Loans Act, 1922, are hereby incorporated with, and shall be deemed part of, this Act as if the said sections had been re-enacted herein, except that the words "Eighty thousand" shall be substituted for the words "One hundred and five thousand" occurring in the third and fourth lines of Section Ten.
