

AN ACT to enable the Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the City of Hobart to borrow any sum or sums of Money not exceeding One hundred thousand Pounds for the purpose of erecting certain Buildings in the City of Hobart, and for the improvement of the Streets and Recreation Grounds of the City, and for other purposes.

HEREAS it is expedient that the Corporation of Hobart should PREAMBLE. be empowered to borrow the sum or sums of money hereinafter specified for the respective purposes hereinafter set forth:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Hobart Corporation Loans Act Short title. (No. 2), 1923."

Interpretation.

- 2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines
 - "The Corporation" means the corporation of the Mayor, aldermen, and citizens of the City of Hobart.
 - "The Council" means the Hobart City Council.

Power to borrow £100,000 for certain purposes.

- 3 It shall be lawful for the Corporation from time to time to borrow and take up at interest on the security of the whole of the revenues of the Corporation, such sum or sums of money as the Council deems necessary for the respective purposes hereinafter in this section set forth, not exceeding in each case the sum of money herein mentioned in respect of each such purpose
 - r. For the construction of new buildings or erections upon any lands the property of or vested in the Corporation, other than upon any public reserve, and generally in the alteration, remodelling and improvement of such lands, and any buildings or erections therein not exceeding

ing the streets of the City of Hobart, and for the reconstruction of any streets with concrete, bituminous, or other material, and for the substitution of any modern form of street construction for that now in existence, and generally, for the purposes of "The Hobart Corporation Acts, 1893-1923," not exceeding

4 The provisions of Sections Four to Ten inclusive of "The Hobart A.D. 1923, Corporation Loans Act, 1922," are hereby incorporated with and shall be deemed part of this Act as if the said sections had been re-enacted herein, except that the words "One hundred thousand" shall be substituted for the words "One hundred and five thousand," No. 14 occurring in the Third and Fourth lines of Section Ten.
