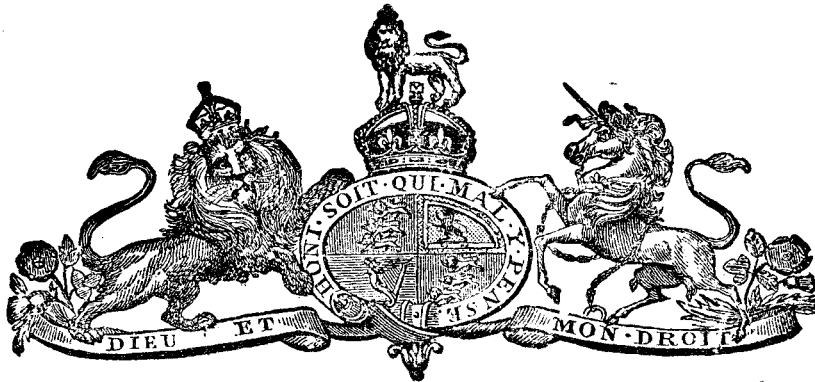

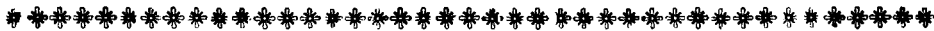

1. Short title.
2. Treasurer may enter into agreement with Huddart Parker Limited in connection with the Hobart-Sydney shipping service. Payment of subsidy.

AN ACT to authorise the Granting of a **1928.**  
 Special Subsidy by way of emergency to  
 Huddart Parker Limited to ensure the  
 Continuance of a Weekly Shipping Service  
 by the Steamship "Zealandia" between  
 Hobart and Sydney for the period of Three  
 Months ending the Eleventh day of April,  
 1929. [18 December, 1928.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by  
 and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and  
 House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—This Act may be cited as "The Huddart Parker (Zealandia) Short title.  
 Subsidy Act, 1928."

*Huddart Parker (Zealandia) Subsidy.*

Treasurer may enter into agreement with Huddart Parker Limited in connection with the Hobart-Sydney shipping service. Payment of subsidy.

2—(1) It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to enter into an agreement with Huddart Parker Limited (hereinafter called "the said Company") for the maintenance of a weekly shipping service by the steanship "Zealandia," to and from Hobart and Sydney, for the period of three months, commencing on or about the twelfth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.

(2) Such agreement—

- i. May provide for the payment by the Treasurer to the said Company out of the Consolidated Revenue of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, which to the necessary extent is hereby appropriated, of a subsidy in respect of such service not exceeding in amount the sum of Two thousand Pounds : and
- ii. Shall be upon such terms and conditions in all other respects as may be agreed upon between the Treasurer and the said Company.
