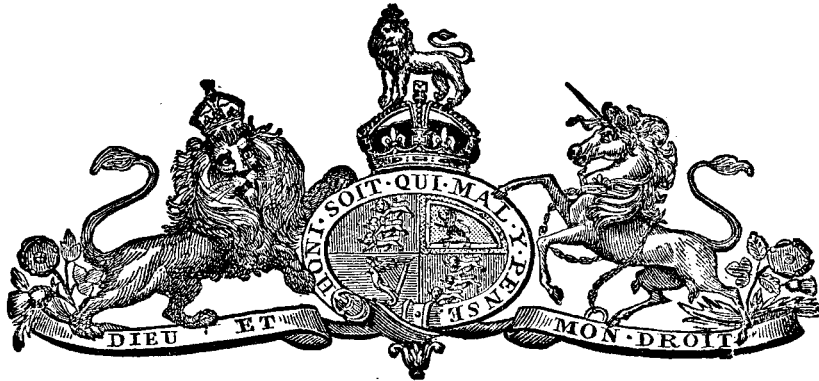

AN ACT to authorise the Executor of the Will of the Reverend *George Clarke*, deceased, to pay certain moneys to the Council of the University of Tasmania. [8 *December*, 1931.]

WHEREAS by a deed of association, dated the twenty-third day of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight, a company or association was formed at Hobart Town for the purpose of establishing and carrying on at Hobart Town aforesaid an institution having for its immediate object the instruction of youth in the higher branches of learning as taught in superior English, Classical, and Mathematical

Schools, but having for its ultimate object the extension of its organisation and its aims concurrently with the growing wants of the community of Van Diemen's Land, and more particularly to obtain for it the privileges of a chartered corporation to confer on Australian youth the inestimable advantages of a European University:

And whereas by the University Property Act the real property of the said company or association was vested in the University of Tasmania:

And whereas the said company or association has long since been dissolved by effluxion of time:

And whereas there are now standing to the credit of the Reverend *George Clarke*, deceased, in the Hobart Savings Bank, certain moneys belonging to the said company or association:

And whereas it is desirable that the said moneys should be paid to the Council of the University of Tasmania:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as "The High School Moneys Disposal Act, 1931."

Power to

2—(1) *Arthur Crosby Walch*, the executor of the will of the Reverend *George Clarke*, deceased, may, without further authority than this Act, pay to the Council of the University of Tasmania the amount of the said moneys standing to the credit of the said *George Clarke*, in the Hobart Savings Bank, less any costs and expenses properly incurred by the said *Arthur Crosby Walch* in connection with the disposal of the said moneys.

(2) The receipt of the Registrar of the University shall be a full and complete discharge to the said *Arthur Crosby Walch* for the said moneys.

3 The Council of the University of Tasmania shall use and apply the said moneys in accordance with the provisions of the Tasmanian University Act.
