

AN ACT to further amend The Hobart Town [25 September, 1862.] Corporation Act.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend The Hobart Town Corpora-PREAMBLE. tion Act by altering the time appointed for holding the Annual 21 Vict. No. 14. Election of Mayor and Aldermen: Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 The Eleventh Section of The Hobart Town Corporation Act is Substitutes new hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof the following enactment shall be Enactment for substituted; that is to say,—On the second Friday in December, in the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, and on the like 21 Vict. No. 14, sec. 11. day in every succeeding year, Three Aldermen shall go out of office by rotation, and on the preceding day an Election shall be held to supply their places; and the persons elected shall assume office on their predecessors going out of office.

- 2 The Mayor shall go out of office as Mayor on the Saturday fol- When Mayor to lowing the second Friday in each December in each year, on which retire. day the Election of Mayor shall annually take place.
- 3 This Act, and The Hobart Town Corporation Act, and The Acts to be read Hobart Town Corporation Amendment Act, except in so far as the together. same are altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
- 4 In referring to this Act, it shall be sufficient to use the expression Short Title. The Hobart Town Corporation Amendment Act, No. 2.
