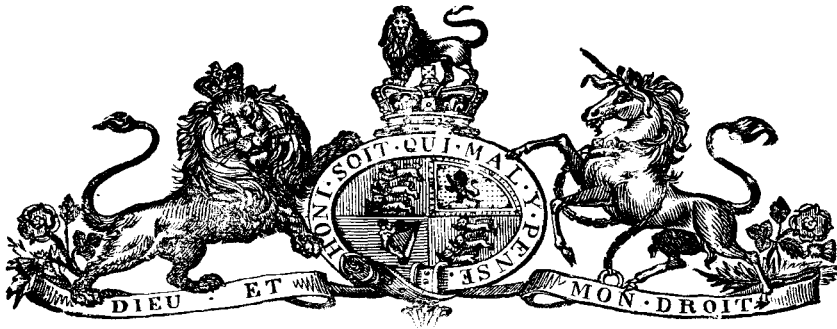

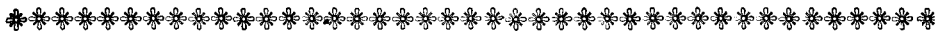

AN ACT to amend *The Hobart Town Paving Act* A.D. 1878.  
[27 January, 1879.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend *The Hobart Town Paving Act*: PREAMBLE.  
30 Vict. No. 15.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** In the construction of *The Hobart Town Paving Act* the words “made, formed, paved, and flagged,” in the first Section of the said Act, shall include the making and forming of any footway, or any part thereof, with stone and cement, or with cement only. Construction.

**2** This Act and *The Hobart Town Paving Act* shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

**3** This Act may be cited as “The *Hobart Town Paving Amendment Act*.” Short title.
