

AN ACT to enable the Mayor, Aldermen, A.D. 1900. and Citizens of the City of *Hobart* to borrow any Sum or Sums of Money, not exceeding £15,000, for the purpose of increasing the Supply of Water to the said City.

[6 December, 1900.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Hobart Water Loan Act, 1900." Short title.
- 2 It shall be lawful for the Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the Mayor, &c., em-City of *Hobart* to borrow, on security of the Water Rates levied under powered to borrow the authority of "The *Hobart* Water Act, 1893." any sum or sums of £15,000. money, not exceeding Fifteen thousand Pounds, for the purpose of increasing the supply of water to the said City.
- 3 If, after having borrowed the said sum, or any part thereof, the Mayor, &c., em-Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the said City pay off the same, it powered to pay shall be lawful for the Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the said off and re-borrow. City again to borrow the amount so paid off, and so from time to time.

Hobart Water Loan.

Loan to be in addition to former loans.

4 The loan authorised by this Act shall be in addition to any sum or sums of money heretofore borrowed by the Mayor, Aldermen, and Citizens of the said City under the authority of any former Act; and the provisions of "The Hobart Corporation Act, 1893," relating to Mortgages of Rates shall be applicable to any sum or sums of money borrowed under this Act.

Loan to be subject to 43 Vict. No. 22.

5 The loan authorised by this Act shall be subject to the provisions of "The City of *Hobart Town* Loans Consolidation Act, 1880," and any Act amending the last-mentioned Act.
