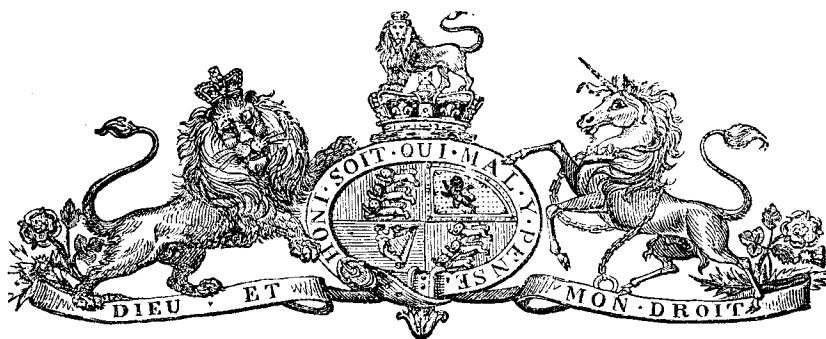

VICTORIÆ REGINÆ,

AN ACT to further amend “The Immigration A.D. 1885.
Act, 1855.” [5 December, 1885.] —

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 From and after the First day of *May* in the year One thousand eight hundred and eighty-six, “The Immigration Act, 1867,” and “The Immigration Act, 1874,” shall be repealed ; but such repeal shall not affect anything duly done under either of the said Acts before this enactment takes effect. 2 The Act of Council of the 19th *Victoria*, No. 18, may be cited as “The Immigration Act, 1855,” and this Act may be cited as “The Immigration Act, 1885.” Short title.
