AN ACT to further amend "The Immigration A.D. 1885. Act, 1855." [5 December, 1885.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 From and after the First day of May in the year One thousand Repeal. eight hundred and eighty-six, "The Immigration Act, 1867," and 31 Vict. No. 26. "The Immigration Act, 1874," shall be repealed; but such repeal shall not affect anything duly done under either of the said Acts before this enactment takes effect.

2 The Act of Council of the 19th Victoria, No. 18, may be Short title. cited as "The Immigration Act, 1855," and this Act may be cited as "The Immigration Act, 1885."
