AN ACT to further amend *The Immigration Act, 1855.* A.D. 1885.
[5 December, 1885.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “ The Immigration (Appropriation) Act, Short title. 1885.”

2 Out of moneys provided by Parliament for that purpose, there shall and may be appropriated, issued, and applied, under the direction and control of the Chief Secretary, a sum of Five thousand Pounds for the purposes of immigration to *Tasmania* on the nominated system, under the Rules and Regulations heretofore made by the Board of Immigration. Appropriation of £5000 for nominated immigration.

3 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer, out of the said sum of Five thousand Pounds, to repay to the *Bangor Slate Quarry Company* any sum of money not exceeding the sum of Two thousand and eighty-eight Pounds, portion of a sum of money deposited by the said Company in the Treasury to defray the cost of the introduction into *Tasmania* of certain immigrants in the year 1885. Repayment to Bangor Company.

4 *The Immigration Act, 1855*, and every amendment thereof, and this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.
