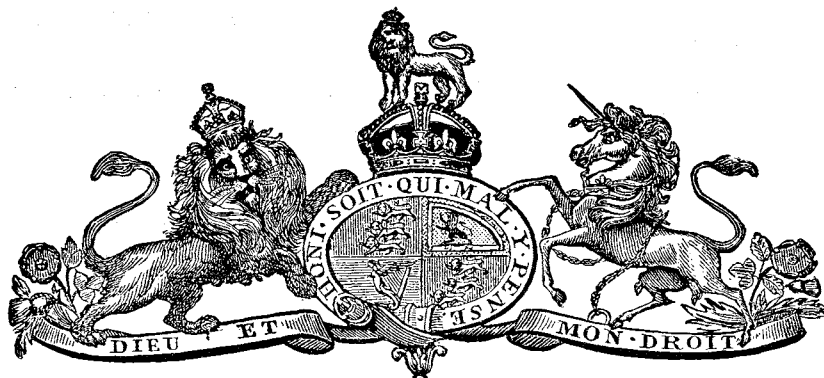

AN ACT to amend "The Insecticides Act, ^{A.D.} 1924.
1913." [6 December, 1924.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Repeal of Section 4 of the Principal Act and substitution of new section.

Standards may be prescribed as to constituents of destructive preparations.

Application for approval of sale of certain destructive preparations.

Amendment of Section 5 of the Principal Act.

Repeal of Section 10 of the Principal Act and substitution of new section.

2 Section Four of the Principal Act is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

“**4**—(1) The Governor may, by proclamation, prescribe a standard for any destructive preparation, fixing all or any of the following matters :—

- i. The constituents that may or shall be contained therein :
- ii. The quantities or proportions of such constituents :
- iii. The chemical or physical conditions of such constituents.

(2) Any person may make an application in writing to the Secretary of Agriculture for the approval by the Governor of the sale of any destructive preparation a standard for which has not been previously prescribed. Upon receipt of such application and a sample of such destructive preparation, the Secretary of Agriculture shall forthwith cause an analysis of such sample to be made by an analyst, and shall report the result thereof in writing to the Minister, who shall make a recommendation thereon to the Governor, and the Governor may by proclamation :—

- i. Approve of the sale of such destructive preparation, and prescribe a standard therefor in accordance with the provisions of Subsection (1) of this section : or
- ii. Prohibit the sale of such destructive preparation.

(3) Any such standard as aforesaid may fix a maximum and a minimum, or a minimum only, of any constituent, or may prohibit the inclusion of any substance as a constituent of the destructive preparation.

(4) The Governor may, by proclamation, abolish or alter any standard prescribed as aforesaid, or proclaim another standard in lieu thereof.”

3 Section Five of the Principal Act is hereby amended as follows :—

- i. By inserting after the figure “5” in the First line thereof the figure “(1)” :
- ii. By deleting the word “fixed” in the First and Third lines of the said section and substituting the word “prescribed” in each of the said lines therefor : and
- iii. By inserting after the end of the said section the following new subsection as Subsection (2) thereof :—

(2) No person shall sell any destructive preparation for which a standard has not been prescribed, or the sale whereof has been prohibited by the Governor by proclamation.

4 Section Ten of the Principal Act is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor :—

“**10** No person shall be bound to accept delivery on sale of any destructive preparation :—

- i. If any of the provisions of Section Seven or Section Eight with respect thereto has not been complied with : or
- ii. If a standard has not been prescribed therefor : or
- iii. If the sale thereof has been prohibited by the Governor by proclamation.”

5 Section Seventeen of the Principal Act is hereby amended by A.D. 1924.
inserting after Paragraph 11. thereof the following new Paragraph 11a.:-

“ 11a The procedure to be adopted and the fees to be paid by
an applicant in respect of an application by him under Sub-
section (2) of Section Four of this Act.”
