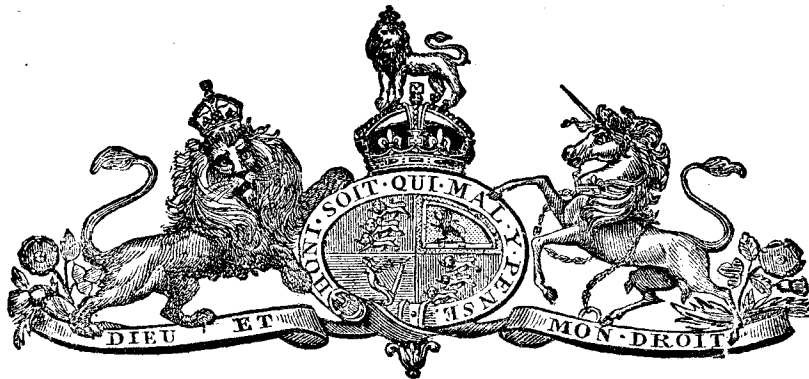

AN ACT to provide for the Vesting of certain A.D. 1928.
 Land in the City of Launceston in His Majesty the King for Police Purposes, and for the Vesting of certain other Land in the said City in the Corporation of the said City, and for other purposes. [7 January, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Inveresk Police Station and Short title, Tramway Sheds Sites Vesting Act, 1928.”

Inveresk Police Station and Tramway Sheds Sites Vesting.

A.D. 1928.
 Interpretation.

2 In this Act—

“The said City” means the City of Launceston :

“The Corporation” means the Mayor, aldermen, and citizens of the said City :

“The said plan” means the plan set out in the schedule :

“The schedule” means the schedule to this Act.

3—(1) The allotment of land, situate in the said City, and shown in the said plan, and therein marked “A,” being portion of certain land which was vested in the Corporation for recreation and other similar purposes, by an Act intituled “An Act to vest part of the East portion of the Launceston Swamp in the Corporation of the Town of Launceston” (hereinafter called “the said Act”), shall hereafter be excluded from the operation of the said Act, and be vested in His Majesty the King for police purposes.

Vesting of road-

(2) The strip of land, twenty feet wide, situate in the said City, and shown in the said plan, and therein marked “B,” being other portion of the land so vested in the Corporation, as aforesaid, shall continue to be vested in the Corporation, but shall be freed from the trusts declared by the said Act, and be held by the Corporation in fee simple, for use as a roadway for all or any of the purposes of the Corporation.

4—(1) The allotment of land, situate in the said City, and shown in the said plan, and therein marked “C,” comprising :—

I. Portion of certain land formerly reserved or intended to be reserved as a public street : and

II. Portion of certain land formerly reserved or intended to be reserved for Government Railway purposes—

is hereby vested in the Corporation in fee simple, as and for a site for sheds and other buildings for use by the Corporation in connection with the tramways and transport services of the Corporation.

(2) The strip of land, ten feet wide, situate in the said City, and shown in the said plan, and therein marked “D,” comprising other portions of the said lands formerly reserved or intended to be reserved as aforesaid, is hereby reserved for the purposes of the Tasmanian Government Railways, subject, however, to full right and liberty for the Corporation, by its officers, servants, agents, and workmen, at all times, by day or by night, and with or without horses, carts, waggons, vehicles, and carriages, laden or unladen, to go, pass, and repass along, over, and upon the said strip of land, ten feet wide, for any purpose in connection with the use by the Corporation of the allotment of land referred to in Subsection (1) of this section.
