

૽ AN ACT to amend the Indeterminate Sen-[16 *December*, 1925.] tences Act, 1921.

A.D. 1925.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Indeterminate Sentences Act, Short title. 1925."
- 2 Section Twenty-one of the Indeterminate Sentences Act, 1921, Amendment of is hereby amended, as follows:
 - i. As to Subsection (1) thereof by deleting the word "Three" Indeterminate in the second line of the said subsection, and substituting 1921. the word "Four" therefor:
 - II. As to Subsection (3) thereof by deleting the word "Two" in the first line of the said subsection, and substituting the word "Three" therefor: and
 - 111. By expunging Subsection (4) thereof, and substituting the following subsection therefor:
 - "(4) Any three members of the Board shall form a quorum."
