

A.D. AN ACT to permit Juries to Separate in 1906. Cases of Felony. [13 September, 1906.]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 This Act may be cited as "The Juries Separation Act, 1906."

Short title.

2 Upon the trial of any person for a felony other than murder, Separation of treason, or treason felony, the Court may, if it see fit, at any time Juries in cases of before the Jury consider their verdict, permit the Jury to separate felony. in the same way as the Jury upon the trial of any person for mis- c. 18. demeanor are now permitted to separate.
