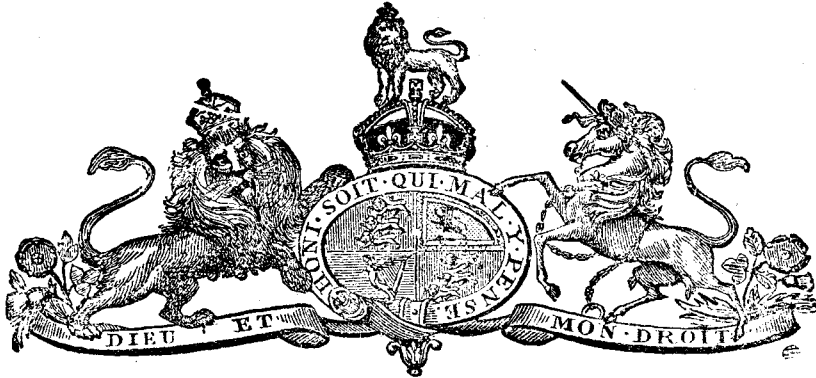

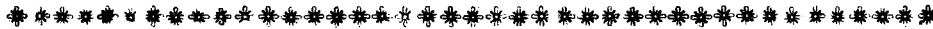

AN ACT to increase the Salaries of the Judges
of the Supreme Court of Tasmania.

[20 December, 1920.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Judges' Salaries Act, 1920."

Short title.

2 Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Constitution Act," or the Act 50 Victoriae No. 36, from and after the First day of July, One thousand nine hundred and twenty there shall be annually paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue as the salary of the person for the time being holding the office of Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, the sum of One thousand eight hundred Pounds; and as the salary of each person for the time being holding the office of Puisne Judge of the Supreme Court, the sum of One thousand five hundred Pounds.
