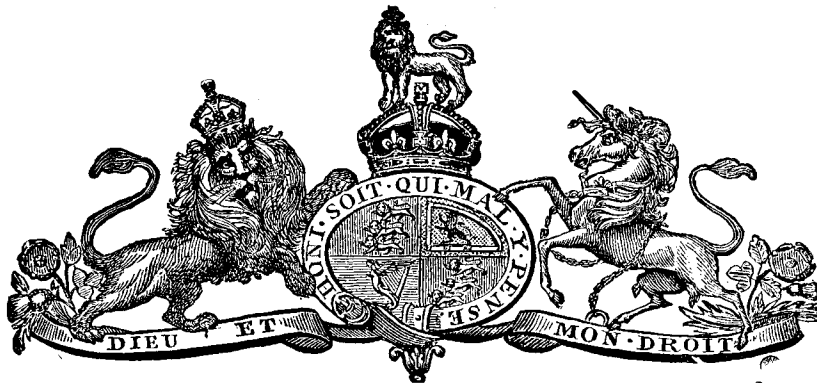

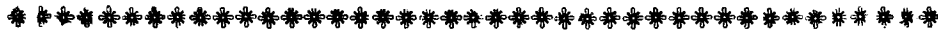

AN ACT to amend "The Lotteries Amendment Act, 1899." A.D. 1923.
[10 April, 1923.] --

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1**—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Lotteries Act, 1923." Short title.
 (2) "The Lotteries Amendment Act, 1899," is herein called "the Principal Act," Principal Act,

2 Section Three of the Principal Act as inserted therein by Section Two of "The Lotteries Amendment Act, 1917," is hereby amended by deleting the words "Twelve Pounds and Ten Shillings" in the eleventh and twelfth lines thereof, and substituting therefor the words "Fifteen Pounds."

3 Section Six of the Principal Act as inserted therein by Section Eight of "The Lotteries Amendment Act, 1917," is hereby amended by deleting the words "Two Pounds and Ten Shillings," in the fourth and fifth lines thereof, and substituting therefor the words "Five Pounds."

4 No Committee to which a licence has been issued under this Act shall accept or receive at or in a totalisator any money from any person in respect of any race, or issue any totalisator ticket in respect of any race, between the time advertised by such Committee in its official programme as the starting-time of such race and the time when the same is actually run, and no such race shall be run without such time being so advertised.

Provided however, that such Committee may, with the approval in writing of the supervising officer appointed under Section Seven of the Principal Act, cancel the advertised starting-time for any race and substitute a later time therefor by notice posted in a conspicuous place upon its racecourse, for not less than Fifteen minutes before such substituted time, and thereupon the foregoing provisions of this section shall relate to such substituted time.

Penalty : Twenty-five Pounds.
