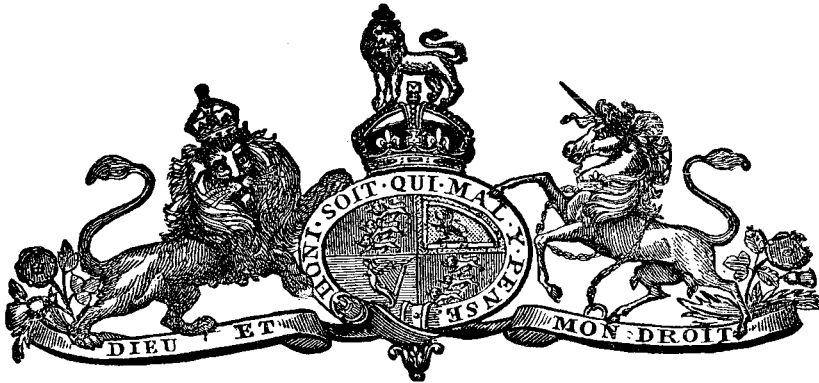

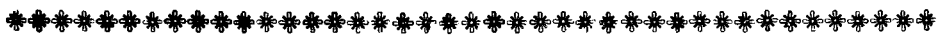

AN ACT to amend "The Licensing Act, 1902." A.D. 1925.  
[6 February, 1925.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Licensing Act, 1925."

Short title.

**2** Section Sixty-nine of "The Licensing Act, 1902," is hereby repealed, and the following new Section Sixty-nine substituted therefor :—

Repeal of Section 69 of 2 Ed. VII. No. 32, and substitution of new section.

"**69**—(1) Every application for a wholesale licence or an importers licence shall be made to the Treasurer in writing and shall set forth the place of residence of the applicant, and in case of a wholesale licence shall state the situation and description of the premises in respect of which the licence is applied for.

“(2) The Treasurer shall refer any such application to the Commissioner of Police who shall thereupon satisfy himself—

- i. That the applicant is a fit and proper person to be the holder of the licence for which he has applied :
- ii. That the premises mentioned in the application are suitable for the purpose : and
- iii. That the granting of a licence in respect of premises in the locality where the premises mentioned in the application are situated is warranted by the requirements of the residents in such locality—

and shall report to the Treasurer thereon.

“(3) The Treasurer may upon payment of the prescribed fee issue any such licence as aforesaid, and the same may be in such of the forms set out in Schedule (10) as may be applicable.”

**3** Schedule (10) to “The Licensing Act, 1902,” is hereby amended by deleting from the form of wholesale licence therein, all the words from and including the word “such” in the third line of the said form down to and including the word “Peace” in the fourth line thereof.
