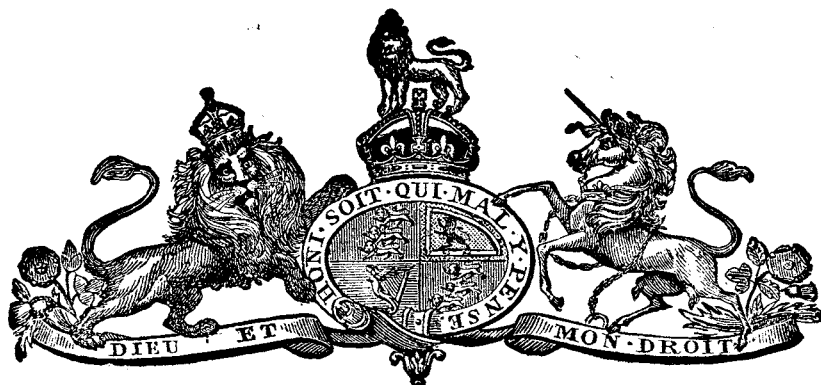

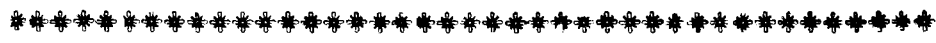

AN ACT to amend the Lotteries Amendment Act, 1899. A.D. 1927.  
[2 December, 1927.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as “The Lotteries Act, 1927.” Short title.
- (2) The Lotteries Amendment Act, 1899, is herein called “the Principal Act.” Principal Act.

**3** Section Six of the Principal Act, inserted therein by Section Eight of the Lotteries Amendment Act, 1917, is hereby amended by deleting the words "Four Pounds" in the fourth line thereof, and substituting the words "Two Pounds and Ten Shillings" therefor.
