

AN ACT to further amend "The Local Bodies A.D. 1900. Loans Act." [6 December, 1900.]

BEit enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and 45 Vict. No. 16. with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Local Bodies Short title. Loans Amendment Act, 1900."
- 2 In this Act the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The Interpretation. Local Bodies Loans Act." 45 Vict. No. 16.
- 3 Notwithstanding anything contained in the said Act it shall be Money forming lawful for the Treasurer at any time to invest on fixed deposit at part of Sinking interest in any bank in *Tasmania* any money forming part of any Sinking Fund created under the provisions of the said Act.

 Honey forming part of Sinking Fund may be invested on fixed deposit.
- 4 This Act, and the said Act, and every Act amending the same, Acts to be read shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
