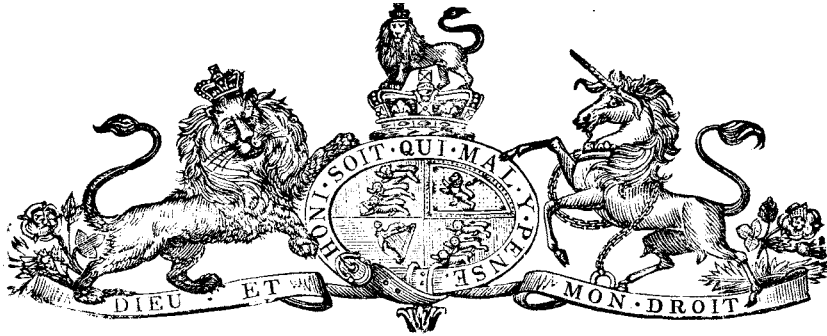

AN ACT to further amend the Launceston Corporation Act, 1894. [3 August, 1931.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend the Launceston Corporation Act, 1894:

PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Corporation Act, 1931."

**2** Section Fifty-one of the Launceston Corporation Act (No. 3), 1924, is hereby repealed, and the following section is hereby inserted in lieu thereof:—

“**51** Until the inclusion day the Corporation may, in the new area, make and levy suburban water rates as heretofore made and levied or may alter the rate from time to time, and may also charge for water and electricity (lighting, heating, and power) as now charged or may alter such charges from time to time as the Corporation may think fit.”

**3** Section Two hundred and ninety-one of the Launceston Corporation Act, 1894, as amended by the Launceston Corporation Act, 1924, is hereby repealed, and the following section is hereby inserted in lieu thereof:—

Committees. “**291** The Council may from time to time appoint out of  
Cf. 58 Vict. their own body such, and so many, committees as the Council  
No. 30, ss. thinks fit for any purposes which, in the discretion of the  
291, 292. Council, would be better regulated, arranged, and managed  
by means of such committees.

14 Geo. V. Such committees may be either of a general or special nature  
No. 60, s. 23. and may consist of the whole Council or of such number of  
persons, not less than three, as the Council thinks fit.

The quorum of any such committee shall be such number, being not less than one-half of the full number of members thereof, as the Council may fix.

The Council may discontinue, alter, or continue any such committee.

Every such committee shall submit its proposals to the Council for approval before carrying them out, unless the Council shall direct that such submission is unnecessary.

This direction as to the submission being unnecessary may be with regard to any particular act or acts or with regard to the whole of the purposes of their appointment.

Where such submission is unnecessary the committee shall nevertheless report to the Council what is done immediately after such particular act or acts, or where no particular act or acts are specified, then at such regular intervals or at such other times as the Council shall from time to time direct.”
