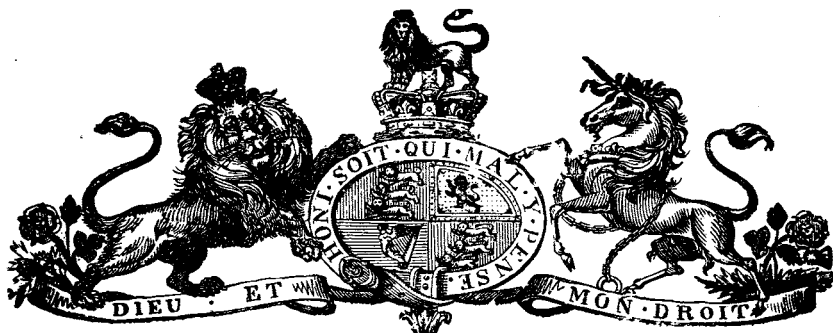

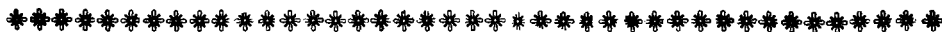

AN ACT to further amend "The *Launceston* Corporation Act, 1894." A.D. 1903.

[10 December, 1903.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The *Launceston* Corporation Act, 1894," and to amend "The *Launceston* Corporation Amendment Act, 1900:" PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as "The *Launceston* Corporation Amendment Act, 1903." Short title.

2 The "Principal Act" shall mean "The *Launceston* Corporation Act, 1894." 58 Vict. No. 30.

3 The words "or which is let to" in the second line, and "weekly or monthly tenants" in the third line, of Section One hundred and nineteen of the Principal Act are hereby expunged. Amendment of Sec. 119 of 58 Vict. No. 30.

Acts to be read together.

4 The word "Thirtieth" is hereby substituted for the word "Twentieth" in Sections Twenty-two, Thirty-one, Thirty-four, and Thirty-five of the Principal Act.

5 The Forms (3.) and (6.) in the Schedule to this Act are hereby substituted for the Forms (3.) and (6.) in the Schedule to the Principal Act.

6 Section Eight of "The *Launceston* Corporation Amendment Act, 1900," is hereby repealed.

7 Notwithstanding anything contained in Section Seventy-seven of the Principal Act, an Alderman shall not be disqualified for his office by reason of being a Returning Officer, Presiding Officer, or Deputy or Assistant Returning Officer, under any Electoral Act.

8 This Act and the Principal Act and all other Acts amending the same shall, save as amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
