## AN ACT to provide for the Erection of a Central School at Launceston. [18 October, 1870.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

1 If a sum of Six hundred Pounds be raised by subscription for that Minister of Lands purpose, it shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause may erect School. to be constructed and completed the necessary buildings and erections for the purposes of a Central School in the Town of Launceston, upon land provided for that purpose by the Board of Education; and such School when so erected shall be vested in and shall be under the management and control of the said Board.

2 Towards defraying the cost of such work, such sum of money not Defrayment of exceeding One thousand and two hundred Pounds, as Parliament cost of work. provides for that purpose, may be appropriated thereto, in addition to the said sum of Six hundred Pounds.

3 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Central School Act." Short Title.
