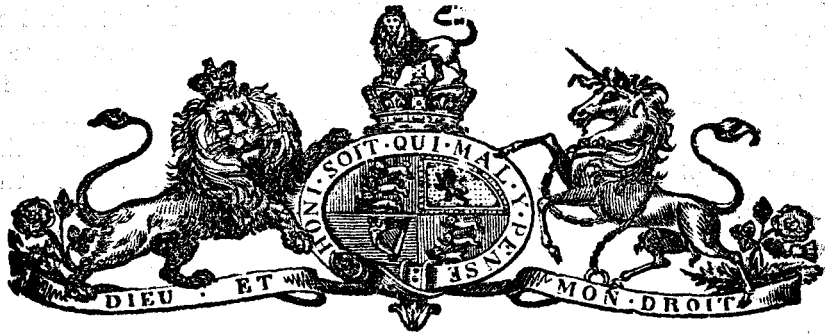

AN ACT to provide for the Erection of a Central School at *Launceston*. [18 October, 1870.]

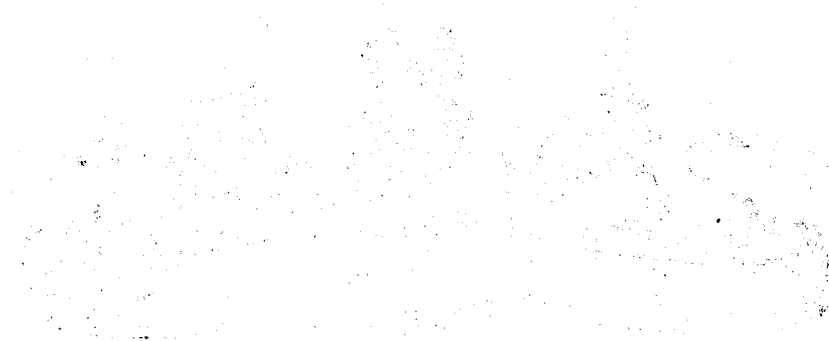
BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 If a sum of Six hundred Pounds be raised by subscription for that purpose, it shall be lawful for the Minister of Lands and Works to cause to be constructed and completed the necessary buildings and erections for the purposes of a Central School in the Town of *Launceston*, upon land provided for that purpose by the Board of Education; and such School when so erected shall be vested in and shall be under the management and control of the said Board. Minister of Lands may erect School.

2 Towards defraying the cost of such work, such sum of money not exceeding One thousand and two hundred Pounds, as Parliament provides for that purpose, may be appropriated thereto, in addition to the said sum of Six hundred Pounds. Defrayment of cost of work.

3 This Act may be cited as "The *Launceston* Central School Act." Short Title.
